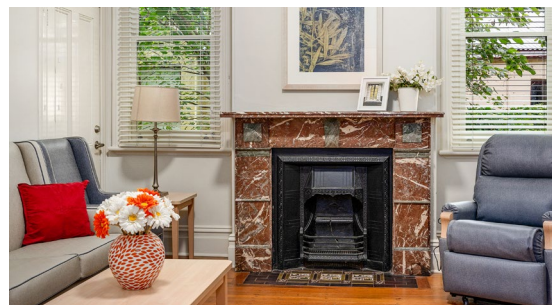
While they're enjoying a change of pace, you can plan a trip, attend appointments, or simply relax and recharge.

Our overnight service allows you to take an extended break. To ensure the COVID-safety of our visitors, we offer comfortable private rooms with single beds.

Ways to pay

If you're eligible for the Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) or a Home Care Package (HCP), you may be able to use these funds to pay for respite at Glen Osmond House. You can also pay to stay with us privately.

Your loved one will feel at home with our:

- Experienced carers, including access to nursing and allied health supports*
- Engaging activities such as gentle exercise, board games, music and art therapy
- Opportunity to socialise and interact with other visitors and staff safely
- Garden courtyard and peaceful, leafy outlook
- Nutritious and delicious meals that are tailored to personal preferences
- Webster-pak® medication assistance.

You'll feel at ease with our:

- Expertise in caring for older people with high care needs
- Preparation of an individualised care plan, together with you
- Proximity to Petersham train station and plenty of street parking
- Flexibility to book in advance and cancel^[**] if your plans change
- Short notice bookings if you fall sick or something unexpected comes up
- Check-in at any time and open 7 days a week
- Network of support for carers.
